### "Sarah"

**Sarai-My princess, the name originally borne by Sarah (Gen. 11:31; 17:15).**

1. Why was it important for Sarah to give birth
2. When Abram asked Sarai to agree to tell Pharaoh that she was his sister were they lying?
3. When Sarah told her husband to lay with Hagar was she wrong? If so how and if not why? And what effect did that act have on man kind
4. Why did Hagar despise Sarai, and what insight or revelation did you get from their situation
5. When the Angel of the Lord appeared to Hagar and said Genesis 16:11

**"Behold, you *are* with child,  
And you shall bear a son.  
You shall call his name Ishmael,  
Because the LORD has heard your affliction.  
<sup>12</sup> He shall be a wild man;  
His hand *shall be* against every man,  
And every man's hand against him.  
And he shall dwell in the presence of all his brethren."**

How do you interpret what was said by the Angel of the Lord. And how would you have felt if the Lord told you the fate of your child.

6. Why do you think God established His covenant between Abraham and Sarah's son Isaac and not Ishmael, and what does that tell you about Gods plan for family and marriage if anything?
7. Sarah laughed when she heard that she would give birth. Have you gotten a vision or revelation from God about your calling or destiny and thought "That just couldn't happen to me" if so please give your testimony even if it hasn't come to pass yet!
8. That fact that Abraham had to tell King Abimelech that Sarah was his sister at age 90 tells you what about Sarah?
9. Was Sarah wrong when she had Abraham to cast out Hagar and Ishmael?
10. What did you learn from Sista Sarah, How can you apply it what you learned to your life?
